ITINERARY

July 29, Thursday – August 10, Tuesday

Registration deadline: August 31, 2026

Extension Day 1 – July 29, Thursday

Arrival in Incheon (B)

- Depart Boston for Incheon, South Korea, and begin your World Youth Day journey
- Overnight on airplane

Extension Day 2 – July 30, Friday

Diocese of Incheon (B)

- Arrive at Incheon International Airport
- Transfer to hotel and check-in
- Celebrate Mass at the hotel or nearby church

Extension Day 3 – July 31, Saturday

Diocese of Incheon (B, D)

- Participate in events of Diocesan Days with the Diocese of Incheon
- Sending-Off Mass with the Bishop of Incheon

Extension Day 4 – August 1, Sunday

Diocese of Incheon (B, D)

- Mass at the Incheon Cathedral, followed by a visit to the Diocese of Incheon Museum
- Free time
- Diocesan festivities and events

Extension Day 5 – August 2, Monday

Diocese of Incheon (B, D)

- Ganghwa Peace Observatory with direct views of North Korea across the water
- Gapgot Martyrs' Shrine for Mass and time for personal prayer
- Transfer to Seoul and check into the hotel

Day 1 – August 1, Sunday

Departure from Boston (D)

- Depart Boston for Incheon, South Korea, and begin your World Youth Day journey
- Overnight on airplane

Day 2 – August 2, Monday

Diocese of Incheon – Archdiocese of Seoul (B, L, D)

- Arrive at Incheon International Airport
- Transfer to Seoul hotel and check-in
- Celebrate Mass at the hotel or nearby church

Day 3 – August 3, Tuesday

Seoul – WYD Opening Mass (B)

- Free morning to explore Seoul using Verso's WYD resources
- Visit churches and shrines along one of the city's walking pilgrimage routes
- WYD Opening Mass celebrated by the Archbishop of Seoul

Day 4 – August 4, Wednesday – Day 6 – August 6, Friday

Morning Catechesis – Youth Festival (B, L, D)

WYD event options:

- Morning Mass with all pilgrims traveling from the Archdiocese of Boston.
- Morning Catechesis sessions with pilgrims and bishops from around the world, including prayer, discussion, and Mass
- Attend Youth Festival events ranging from concerts and speakers to the Sacrament of Reconciliation and fellowship
- Explore the Vocations Fair
- Large evening event

Day 7 – August 7, Saturday

Walking Pilgrimage – Overnight Vigil (B, L, D)

- Pilgrimage to the Vigil site, typically a 12-15 mile walk
- Join with the Pope and fellow pilgrims for a vigil prayer service and other prayer and social activities
- Sleep under the stars and prepare for the final day
- Overnight at the Vigil Site

Day 8 – August 8, Sunday

Closing Mass – Seoul (B, L)

- The morning begins early with closing activities, including music, speakers, and prayers, followed by the closing Papal Mass with the Holy Father
- Return to the hotel and enjoy a free afternoon and evening to relax after a long day

Day 9 – August 9, Monday

Departure from Seoul (B, D)

- Free day to explore Seoul. Choose your own adventure! Ascend Namsam Tower, pray at striking shrines such as Dangoggae or Seosomun, taste local delicacies at Gwangjang Market, explore Bukchon Hanok Village, or visit one of the five traditional palaces throughout the city (all activities on your own)
- Enjoy a final Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant as a large group after a final Mass.

Day 10 – August 10, Tuesday

Departure from Seoul (B)

- Transfer to the Incheon International Airport
- Depart Seoul for Boston

* Please note: Saturday lunch, Saturday dinner, Sunday breakfast, and Sunday lunch are provided by the WYD Vigil Meal Kits. Pilgrims who do not attend the overnight Vigil will be responsible for these four meals on their own.
